Application period of Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) Scholarships opens from April through to May 2018. Application for the scholarship is fully automated and applicants have the options of downloading an online application form or collecting one at the Embassy, located on the 6th floor of North Tower, 2 Oxford Road, Kingston 5.

2019 MEXT Scholarships for Jamaica, Belize and The Bahamas

Research (Graduate) Students – Jamaicans, Belizeans and Bahamians

This scholarship is open to university graduates from Jamaica, The Bahamas and Belize, and covers a one year and half – two year period of graduate research at Japanese universities. The study area must be in the same field as the applicant studied or is now studying, or a related field. Recipients may enter Master's or Ph.D. program after passing the entrance examination given by the university concerned. The scholarship includes a half-year of Japanese language training for those who need Japanese language training. Applicants must be less than 35 years of age (born on or after April 2, 1984).

Undergraduate Students – Jamaicans, Belizeans and Bahamians

This scholarship is open to Jamaican, Bahamian and Belizean high school graduates and above, and covers a five years period of undergraduate studies including a one-year Japanese language program at a Japanese language school prior to attending a Japanese university as an undergraduate student. Recipients will receive a bachelor's degree in Japan. Applicants must be between 17 to 25 years of age (must be born between April 2, 1994 and April 1, 2002), and must have completed 12 years of education by March 2019 or have completed courses in a school comparable to a high school. Applicants must have excellent grades for the last three years in high school.

This scholarship is open to Jamaican high school graduates and above and covers a four-year period of technical study in the following areas: civil engineering, architecture, electrical engineering, electronics, and others (please see the document which states Majors and Related Key Terms for Field of Study for further details). The scholarship includes a one-year Japanese language program at a Japanese Training College. It is available to high school graduates who are between 17 to 25 years of age (must be born between April 2, 1994 and April 1, 2002). Applicants must have excellent high school grades.
